Striking changes are more visible from the aspect of religious behavior besides other aspects. Changes in religious behavior as a result of the transformation of media information are indicated by the morality of society which sometimes ignores religious values. So the presence of the media must be responded to so that it has a positive impact on people's religious behavior and maintains the values that society has adhered to. The presence of media has a negative impact on religious behavior, if seen from the attitude of people who access information unselectively (Nurul Syobah, 2013).

The Indonesian Malay Cultural Traditional Council or MABMI Langkat Regency is an ethnic organization that was founded in 1971 and has strengthened its network. Because the founders and main figures have served as Regent and other high positions. So the existence of the Indonesian Malay Cultural Traditional Council in Langkat Regency is very influential in political and religious events. Both from political parties, community organizations, youth organizations, other ethnic organizations and even religious organizations (Erwin Jusuf Thaib, 2019).

In connection with this strengthening, the Indonesian Malay Cultural Traditional Council of Langkat Regency is aware that communication media is very much needed to establish good relations both within the Indonesian Malay Cultural Traditional Council and external circles. So communication media has been optimized to strengthen networks for all parties, be it government, political organizations, community and religious organizations.

enlightenment for the people in discovering or solving life's problems so that they remain istiqamah, consistent, and carry out the religious values they believe in (Nur Ahmad, 2016).

Islam as a missionary religion requires it to be disseminated to the community. Da'wah activities are believed to have an influence on the progress of Islam. On the other hand, weak da'wah activities will have an impact on the decline of Islam. Da'wah is the most important path and is an activity carried out with iltizam on the path of da'wah which really determines the fate of every Muslim to have a firm belief in the safety of the direction of the da'wah journey itself (Fathurrahman, 2016).

Preaching through communication media by the Indonesian Malay Cultural Customary Council of Langkat Regency is a noble task in the hope that they can fight for the truth by enforcing amar ma'ruf and nahi munkar on a wider scale through communication media in Langkat Regency and refracting the meaning of da'wah in social life in generally.
